<u>Gordon Phillips</u> Tuck at Dartmouth <u>Gordon Phillips</u> is the Laurence F. Whittemore Professor of Business Administration and a professor of finance at the Tuck School of Business. He is also a research associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER) and a visiting research professor at Tsinghua University in Beijing. He received his MA and Ph.D. from Harvard University and his undergraduate degree from Northwestern University.

His areas of research include computational linguistics, AI and finance, household finance, corporate finance and how financial decisions impact firms' strategic decisions, and contracting in financial markets.



Jan Kinne is co-founder and CEO of <u>ISTARI.AI</u>. They provide real-time market and company information. In addition, he has been a member of the ZEW Research Unit "Economics of Innovation and Industrial Dynamics" since June 2016.
