With fellow PhD student, Jana-Lynn Schuster, Paulina helped co-organize the PhD Conference in Finance at Goethe University Frankfurt and attended the Rising Scholar Conference in Finance at the University of Zurich.

Jana-Lynn Schuster joined Frankfurt School as a Finance PhD candidate in September 2023. Her academic journey began with a Bachelor's in Economics and Business Administration at Goethe University, continued with a Master's in Quantitative Economics, and featured a layover in Venice. Along the way, she gained research experience at the German Council of Economic Experts and the Kiel Institute for the World Economy, contributing to projects on monetary policy and sovereign debt as a research assistant.

Jana's research interests are in financial intermediation and macro-finance. Current projects study firms' short-term financing choices and their implications for financial stability, alongside household inflation expectations.



Beyond her own research, Jana-Lynn actively shapes the PhD community. She recently coorganized the third Bonn–Frankfurt–Mannheim PhD Conference and currently serves as Finance PhD representative.
